Jericho to Jerusalem...the Way of the Pilgrimage Three times a year Israelites (particularly males) were summoned to come to the central sanctuary to recall, rehearse, and transmit the stories of Yahweh's great acts of rescue in the Exodus. Passover, Shavuot (Feast of Weeks) or Pentecost, Succoth (Feast of Tabernacles) Deut 16 (Picture ix, map ivb, map iii) This was the path Mary and Joseph would' ve traveled when they brought Jesus to Jerusalem prior to his bar mitzveh Lk 2:42.

Jericho OT...Joshua, priests and ark and Jordan at flood stage...recalls Israel's experience at the Red Sea...stones of remembrance...Gilgal. Josh 4. The Point of Entry OT and NT Jericho NT...First Exodus/Second Exodus...Scene of two remarkable conversions, Bartimeaus (Bar/son of Timeaus) Zaccheaus Chief Tax Collector Mk 10:46; Lk 18:35; 19:1

Bethany beyond the Jordan Jn 1:28...Place of Transfer: Moses Joshua, Elijah Elisha, John the Baptist Jesus. Place of Entry and exit Deut 34; 2 Kings 2; Mt 14; Mk 6 and founding of the Kingdom of God.

Deuteronomy: Constitution for life in the Land...Lease agreement Temptation...Adam, another link to the Garden of Eden and Promised Land...Jesus faces the Evil One...Deuteronomy quotes, territorial claim...notice given of usurper's Coming eviction.


Palm Sunday pathway...same as Solomon on foal of an ass, symbol of peace, Jesus enters on lamb selection day appearing like Solomon on the day of his anointing as King 1 Kings 1. Those who are able will walk this path. Mount of Olives, Lazarus' tomb (Jn 11, 12), (Picture xvi) Ascension (Lk 24, Acts 1), Eze 9, 10, 11...drama. Mount of Olives...Expected place of Second Coming Zech14.


